An Act to amend the Land and Environment Court Act 1979 to provide for the hearing of certain proceedings under the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974. [Assented to. 4 December 1986]

**BE** it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Legislative Assembly of New South Wales in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**Short title**

1. This Act may be cited as the "Land and Environment Court (Marine Mammals Protection) Amendment Act 1986".

**Commencement**

2. (1) Sections 1 and 2 shall commence on the date of assent to this Act.

(2) Except as provided by subsection (1), this Act shall commence on the commencement of the National Parks and Wildlife (Marine Mammals Protection) Amendment Act 1986.

**Amendment of Act No. 204, 1979**

3. The Land and Environment Court Act 1979 is amended in the manner set forth in Schedule 1.
