Act No. 142, 1989

An Act to amend the Area Health Services Act 1986 in order to remove certain disqualifications from eligibility for election as the elected staff member of an area health board. [Assented to 25 October 1989]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Area Health Services (Elections) Amendment Act 1989.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

Amendment of Area Health Services Act 1986 No. 50

3. The Area Health Services Act 1986 is amended by omitting clause 2 (5) of Schedule 4 and by inserting instead the following subclause:

(5) A person's nomination as a candidate for election as the elected staff member is invalid if:

- (a) the nomination is not made by at least 2 persons who are employees of the relevant health service; or
- (b) the person is not, at the time of nomination, an employee of the relevant area health service.
