Act No. 21, 1989

An Act to amend the National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 with respect to the protection of marine mammals. [Assented to 20 April 1989]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the National Parks and Wildlife (Marine Mammals Protection) Amendment Act 1989.

Commencement

2. This Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

Amendment of National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 No. 80, sec. 99 (Taking or killing etc. endangered fauna)

- 3. The National Parks and Wildlife Act 1974 is amended—
- (a) by inserting at the end of section 99 (1) (b) the following matter:

; or

- (c) approach a marine mammal any closer than such distance as may be prescribed by the regulations or interfere with a marine mammal.
- (b) by inserting after section 99 (3) the following subsections:

(4) A reference in section 112F, 120, 129 or 171 to taking or killing any fauna includes, so far as is applicable in relation to a marine mammal, approaching or interfering with the marine mammal as referred to in subsection (1) (c).

(5) In this section—

"interfere with" includes harass, chase, herd, tag, mark and brand.
