Act No. 17,1990

An Act to reduce the number of politicians in the Legislative Assembly from 109 to 99. [Assented to 14 June 1990]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

Short title

1. This Act may be cited as the Constitution (Legislative Assembly) Amendment Act 1990.

Commencement

2 This Act commences on the date of assent.

Amendment of Constitution Act 1902 No. 32

3. The Constitution Act 1902 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Transitional provisions

- **4.** (1) For the purposes of the first distribution of electoral districts after the date of assent to this Act and of any matters necessary or incidental to that distribution, the amendment made by Schedule 1 commences on that date.
- (2) The amendment made by Schedule 1 applies to and in respect of the number of Members of the Legislative Assembly to be returned at the general election to be held next after the distribution referred to in subsection (1), and comes into force for all purposes as on and from that general election.
