Act No 11, 1996

An Act to amend the *Exhibited Animals Protection Act 1986* with respect to the licensing of zoological parks established, maintained or controlled by the Zoological Parks Board and the Chairperson of the advisory committee. [Assented to 5 June 1996]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Exhibited Animals Protection Amendment Act* 1996.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day or days to be appointed by proclamation.

3 Amendment of Exhibited Animals Protection Act 1986 No 123

The *Exhibited Animals Protection Act 1986* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 5 Savings and transitional provisions

(Section 55)

Chairperson of advisory committee

The person holding office as Chairperson of the advisory committee under clause 2 (1) of Schedule 1 as in force immediately before the commencement of Schedule 1 [4] to the *Exhibited Animals Protection Amendment Act 1996*:

- (a) ceases to hold that office on that commencement, and
- (b) is not entitled to any remuneration or compensation because of the loss of that office.
