Act No 3, 1996

An Act to repeal the *Bread Act 1969*, and to make other consequential repeals and amendments. [Assented to 13 May 1996]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the Bread Repeal Act 1996.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

3 Repeals

Each Act specified in Schedule 1 is repealed.
