## **Annual Holidays Amendment Act** 1997 No 26

Act No 26, 1997

An Act to amend the *Annual Holidays Act 1944* to provide for the preservation of annual holiday entitlements of workers where there is a transfer of ownership of a business; and to make a consequential amendment to the *Industrial Relations Act 1996*. [Assented to 25 June 1997]

#### The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

#### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Annual Holidays Amendment Act 1997.

#### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

#### 3 Amendment of Annual Holidays Act 1944 No 31

The *Annual Holidays Act 1944* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.1.

#### 4 Consequential amendment of Industrial Relations Act 1996 No 17

The *Industrial Relations Act 1996* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.2.

## 4B Protection of annual holiday entitlements on transfer of business

Part 8 of Chapter 2 of the *Industrial Relations Act 1996* applies for the purposes of determining a worker's entitlements under this Act when the worker is employed by an employer as a result of the transfer of business (within the meaning of that Part) to that employer from another employer on or after the commencement of this section.

#### 1.2 Industrial Relations Act 1996

#### **Section 101 Definitions**
