## Motor Accidents Amendment (Board of Directors) Act 1997 No 91

Act No 91, 1997

An Act to amend the *Motor Accidents Act 1988* with respect to the number of part-time directors of the Board of Directors of the Motor Accidents Authority. [Assented to 4 November 1997]

#### The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

#### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the Motor Accidents Amendment (Board of Directors) Act 1997.

#### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on a day to be appointed by proclamation.

#### 3 Amendment of Motor Accidents Act 1988 No 102

The *Motor Accidents Act* 1988 is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

(b) not less than 7 and not more than 10 part-time directors appointed by the Governor on the recommendation of the Minister.

Omit "7".

### [3] Schedule 2 Constitution and procedure of the Board of Directors of the Authority

Omit clause 13. Insert instead:

#### 13 Quorum

The quorum for a meeting of the Board is a majority of directors for the time being.

### Part 9 Provisions arising from enactment of Motor Accidents Amendment (Board of Directors) Act 1997

#### 23 Constitution of Board of Directors

The amendments to section 84 made by the *Motor Accidents Amendment (Board & Directors) Act 1997* do

not affect the appointment or term of office of a person who held office as a part-time director of the Board of Directors of the Authority immediately before the amendments took effect.
