Act No 54, 1999

An Act to amend the *Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Act 1998* to provide for the application of that Act to the Department of Corrective Services. [Assented to 22 November 1999]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Law Enforcement and National Security (Assumed Identities) Amendment (Corrective Services) Act 1999*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent.
