Occupational Health and Safety Amendment (Police Officers) Act 2000 No 11

Act No 11, 2000

An Act to amend the *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1983* with respect to police officers. [Assented to 8 May 2000]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Occupational Health and Safety Amendment (Police Officers) Act 2000*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent.

3 Amendment of Occupational Health and Safety Act 1983 No 20

The *Occupational Health and Safety Act 1983* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

Schedule 1 Amendments

(Section 3)

[1] Section 4 Definitions

Insert after section 4 (3):

(3A) To avoid doubt, a police officer is, for the purposes of this Act:

- (a) an employee of the Crown, and
- (b) at work throughout the time when the officer is on duty at any place, but not otherwise.

[2] Schedule 8 Savings and transitional provisions

Insert at the end of the Schedule:

Part 5 Provisions consequent on enactment of Occupational Health and Safety Amendment (Police Officers) Act 2000

23 Pending proceedings

Section 4 (3A), as inserted by the *Occupational Health and Safety Amendment (Police Officers) Act 2000*, extends to acts, matters or things that are the subject of proceedings commenced, but not finally determined, before the commencement of that Act.
