

# **Motor Accidents Compensation Further Amendment (Terrorism) Act 2002 No 113**

Act No 113, 2002

An Act to amend the *Motor Accidents Compensation Act 1999* to extend for 12 months until 1 January 2004 the temporary exclusion of acts of terrorism from the compulsory third-party insurance coverage provided under that Act. [Assented to 5 December 2002]

**The Legislature of New South Wales enacts:**

**1 Name of Act**

This Act is the *Motor Accidents Compensation Further Amendment (Terrorism) Act 2002*.

**2 Commencement**

This Act commences on the date of assent.

**3 Amendment of Motor Accidents Compensation Act 1999 No 41**

The *Motor Accidents Compensation Act 1999* is amended by omitting “1 January 2003” wherever occurring from sections 15A (3) and 35A (3) and by inserting instead “1 January 2004”.
