# **RSL NSW Amendment Act 2022 No 23**

Act No 23, 2022

An Act to amend the RSL NSW Act 2018 to provide that duty is not payable under the Duties Act 1997 in relation to an act, matter or thing to give effect to the incorporation, under the Corporations Act 2001 of the Commonwealth, of a sub-Branch of RSL NSW as a company limited by guarantee. [Assented to 6 June 2022]

## The Legislature of New South Wales enacts—

#### 1 Name of Act

This Act is the RSL NSW Amendment Act 2022.

#### 2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

## Schedule 1 Amendment of RSL NSW Act 2018 No 48

#### **Section 15A**

Insert after section 15—

### 15A Application of Duties Act 1997

- (1) This section applies if, with the approval of RSL NSW, a sub-Branch incorporates under the *Corporations Act 2001* of the Commonwealth as a company limited by guarantee.
- (2) Duty is not chargeable under the *Duties Act 1997* in relation to an act, matter or thing to give effect to the incorporation, including in relation to the transfer of assets, rights or liabilities from the unincorporated sub-Branch to the incorporated sub-Branch.
- (3) In this section—

**sub-Branch** means a sub-Branch of RSL NSW within the meaning of the RSL NSW Constitution.
