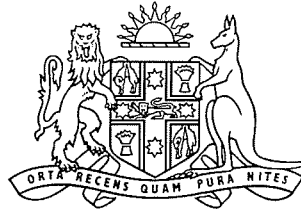

Crimes Legislation Amendment (Domestic Violence and Sexual Offences) Act 2025 No 74

Act No 74, 2025

An Act to amend the *Crimes Act 1900*, the *Crimes (Domestic and Personal Violence) Act 2007* and the *Crimes (Sentencing Procedure) Act 1999* to make miscellaneous amendments in relation to domestic violence and sexual offences. [Assented to 24 November 2025]

The Legislature of New South Wales enacts—

1 Name of Act

This Act is the *Crimes Legislation Amendment (Domestic Violence and Sexual Offences) Act 2025*.

2 Commencement

This Act commences on the date of assent to this Act.

[1] Part 4 Sentencing procedures for imprisonment

Insert in appropriate order in Division 1A, Table—

1C	Murder—where the victim is an intimate partner, within the meaning of the <i>Crimes Act 1900</i> , Part 3, Division 6A, of the offender	25 years
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[2] Schedule 2 Savings, transitional and other provisions

Insert at the end of the schedule, with appropriate part and clause numbering—

**Part Provision consequent on Crimes Legislation
Amendment (Domestic Violence and Sexual
Offences) Act 2025**

Standard non-parole periods

Part 4, Division 1A, Table, as in force immediately before its amendment by the *Crimes Legislation Amendment (Domestic Violence and Sexual Offences) Act 2025*, continues to apply in relation to the offence of murder committed before the amendment.
