### Name of Policy 1

This Policy is State Environmental Planning Policy (Major Projects) 2005 (Amendment No 9).

## 2 **Aims of Policy**

The aim of this Policy is to enable the carrying out of development for the purposes of redeveloping the Royal North Shore Hospital and Liverpool Hospital redevelopment sites to be declared to be critical infrastructure projects for the purposes of Part 3A of the Act.

# Land to which Policy applies 3

This Policy applies to:

- the Royal North Shore Hospital redevelopment site, being the land comprising the following:
  - lots 21 and 22, DP 863329, (i)
  - lot 102, DP 1075748, and
- the Liverpool Hospital redevelopment site, being the land (b) comprising the following:
  - lots 1, 2 and 3, DP 827031,
  - (ii) lots 1, 3 and 101, and part lot 2, DP 596770,
  - (iii) lot 2, DP 805696,
  - lot 1, DP 863491, (iv)
  - lot 1, DP 581947, (v)
  - (vi) lot A, DP 432628,
  - (vii) lots A and B, DP 404723,
  - (viii) lot 1, DP 724028,
    - lots 2 to 13 (inclusive), DP 758628, (ix)
    - (x) part of the main southern railway line,
    - Hart Street, and part of Lachlan Street, Liverpool. (xi)

# **Royal North Shore Hospital redevelopment site**

In this clause:

RNSH redevelopment site means the land comprising the following:

- lots 21 and 22, DP 863329, (a)
- (b) lot 102, DP 1075748.
- (2) Development for the purposes of redeveloping the RNSH redevelopment site, including development for any of the following purposes:
  - refurbishing or replacing the main hospital buildings and emergency service facilities,
  - commercial premises along Herbert Street providing community health and primary care services and research and education facilities,
  - other commercial uses (including for research and (c) technology purposes),
  - vehicular and pedestrian access to and from, and within, (d) the site (including direct pedestrian access to St Leonards Station),
  - accommodation for people receiving acute medical or other health-related services,
  - retail and residential uses.

# **Liverpool Hospital redevelopment site**

In this clause:

Liverpool Hospital redevelopment site means the land comprising the following:

- lots 1, 2 and 3, DP 827031,
- lots 1, 3 and 101, and part lot 2, DP 596770, (b)
- lot 2, DP 805696, (c)
- lot 1, DP 863491, (d)
- lot 1, DP 581947, (e)

  - (c) accommodation for students, nursing and medical staff and patients' relatives,
  - (d) pedestrian access to and from, and within, the site,
  - (e) internal and access roads,
  - (f) landscaping.
