# **Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 1996** (Amendment No 49)

### 1 Name of plan

This plan is Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 1996 (Amendment No 49).

#### 2 Aims of plan

This plan aims to prohibit development for the purpose of a service station on land that is within one kilometre of the Pacific Highway or any by-pass along the route of that Highway and, in either case, that is within Zone No 1 (a) under *Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 1996* (the 1996 plan).

## 3 Land to which plan applies

This plan applies to land in the local government area of Great Lakes that is within one kilometre of the Pacific Highway or any by-pass along the route of that Highway and, in either case, that is within Zone No 1 (a) under the 1996 plan.

#### 4 Amendment of Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 1996

*Great Lakes Local Environmental Plan 1996* is amended by inserting after clause 35 the following clause:

### 36 Service stations along Pacific Highway or by-passes

#### **Objective of Provision**

To prohibit service station development on land that is within one kilometre of the Pacific Highway or any by-pass along the route of that Highway and, in either case, that is within Zone No 1 (a).

#### Prohibition of service station development

Development for the purpose of a service station is prohibited on land that is within one kilometre of the Pacific Highway or any by-pass along the route of that Highway and, in either case, that is within Zone No 1 (a).
