### **State Environmental Planning Policy (Repeal of REP Provisions) 2009**

under the

Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979

#### **1 Name of Policy**

This Policy is *State Environmental Planning Policy (Repeal of REP Provisions) 2009*.

#### **2 Commencement**

This Policy commences on the day on which it is published on the NSW legislation website.

#### **3 Aims of Policy**

The aim of this Policy is to repeal regional environmental plans and provisions of regional environmental plans that are redundant.

#### **4 Repeal of Policy**

- (1) This Policy is repealed on the day following the day on which this Policy commences.
- (2) The repeal of this Policy does not, because of the operation of sections 5 (6) and 30 of the *Interpretation Act 1987*, affect any amendment made by this Policy.
