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1 Name of Plan

- (c) 1 Bligh Street, Riverstone, being part of Lots 191 and 192, DP 1007,
- (d) certain land at Bligh Street, Riverstone, being part of Lot 195, DP 1007,
- (e) 2 Bligh Street, Riverstone, being part of Lot 2, DP 1178963,
- (f) certain land at Kunic Street, Riverstone, being part of Lot 103, DP 1216448,
- (g) 279 Railway Terrace, Schofields being part of Burdekin Road reserve and Lot 13, DP 1190259,
- (h) certain land at Quakers Road, Quakers Hill, being part of Lot 7, DP 4455,
- (i) certain land at Richmond Road, Marsden Park being part of Lots 1 and 2, DP 270819 and part of Lot 2, DP 1198299,
- (j) 2 Hollinsworth Road, Marsden Park, being part of Lot 101, DP 1169158.
