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Environmental Planning and Assessment Act 1979

1 Name of Policy

This Policy is *State Environmental Planning Policy (Mining, Petroleum Production and Extractive Industries) Amendment (No 2) 2021*.

This Policy is repealed on the day following the day on which this Policy commences.

Petroleum exploration, petroleum production and petroleum related works on land within the following local government areas—

- (e) Mid-Western Regional,
- (f) Muswellbrook,
- (g) Narromine,
- (h) Tamworth Regional,
- (i) Upper Hunter,
- (j) Walgett,
- (k) Warren.

Petroleum exploration, petroleum production and petroleum related works within the following local government areas, excluding land identified as “Land where petroleum exploration, petroleum production and petroleum related works are not prohibited” on the map marked “State Environmental Planning Policy (Mining, Petroleum Production and Extractive Industries) 2007—Map 11—New England North West Region”—

- (a) Gunnedah,
- (b) Liverpool Plains,
- (c) Moree Plains,
- (d) Narrabri,
- (e) Warrumbungle.
