1 Name of Policy

This Policy is State Environmental Planning Policy Amendment (Coastal Mapping and Native Vegetation) 2022.

2 Commencement

This Policy commences on 3 October 2022 and is required to be published on the NSW legislation website.

3 Maps

The maps adopted by *State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards)* 2021, Chapter 2 are amended or replaced, as the case requires, by the maps approved by the Minister on the making of this Policy.

4 Repeal of Policy

This Policy is repealed at the beginning of the day following the day on which this Policy commences.

Schedule 1 Amendments

1.1 State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards) 2021

Section 2.2 Interpretation

Omit the definitions of Coastal Environment Area Map, Coastal Use Area Map, Coastal Vulnerability Area Map and Coastal Wetlands and Littoral Rainforests Area Map.

Insert in alphabetical order—

Coastal Environment Area Map means the State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards) 2021 Coastal Environment Area Map.

Coastal Use Area Map means the State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards) 2021 Coastal Use Area Map.

Coastal Vulnerability Area Map means the State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards) 2021 Coastal Vulnerability Area Map.

Coastal Wetlands and Littoral Rainforests Area Map means the State Environmental Planning Policy (Resilience and Hazards) 2021 Coastal Wetlands and Littoral Rainforests Area Map.

1.2 State Environmental Planning Policy (Biodiversity and Conservation) 2021

Section 2.9 Vegetation to which Part applies

Insert after section 2.9(2)—

- (3) This Part also applies to vegetation in a non-rural area of the State that, immediately before the commencement of this subsection, was—
 - (a) declared by a development control plan to be vegetation to which *State Environmental Planning Policy (Vegetation in Non-Rural Areas) 2017*, Part 3 applies, or
 - (b) prescribed by a development control plan under the standard instrument set out in the *Standard Instrument (Local Environmental Plans) Order* 2006, clause 5.9, as in force immediately before 25 August 2017.
