1 Name of plan

Schedule 1 Amendment of Lismore Local Environmental Plan 2012

- [1] Clause 4.2C Erection of dual occupancies (detached) in Zone RU1**
Insert “or adjoining land” after “the land” in clause 4.2C(2)(a).
- [2] Clause 4.2C(2)(b) and (c)**
Omit the paragraphs.
- [3] Clause 4.2E Exceptions to minimum subdivision lot sizes for certain split zones**
Insert “Zone RU2 Rural Landscape,” after “Zone RU1 Primary Production,” wherever occurring in clause 4.2E(2)(b) and (3)(a)(i) and (ii).
- [4] Clause 6.7 Dual occupancies (detached) in Zone R5**
Omit clause 6.7(2)(a) and (b).
- [5] Schedule 5 Environmental heritage**
Omit “Lot 2, DP 700634” from Part 1, item no I78. Insert instead “Lot 2, DP 1285076”.
