Citation

1. This Regulation may be cited as the Summary Offences (Short Description of Offences) (Repeal and Transitional) Regulation 1996.

Commencement

2. This Regulation commences on 26 April 1996.

Repeal

3. The Summary Offences (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1988 is repealed.

Transitional

4. (1) This clause applies to any information, complaint, summons, warrant, notice, order or other document (whether issued, given or made before or after the repeal of the Summary Offences (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1988) that relates to an offence alleged to have been committed before that repeal.

(2) The repeal of the Summary Offences (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1988 does not affect the validity of any information, complaint, summons, warrant, notice, order or other document in which an expression prescribed by that Regulation is used.

EXPLANATORY NOTE

This Regulation repeals the Summary Offences (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1988 in consequence of its having been superseded by a regulation under the Summary Offences Act 1987.

This Regulation is made under the Justices Act 1902, including section 154 (the general regulation-making power) and section 145B.

This Regulation is made in connection with the staged repeal of subordinate legislation under the Subordinate Legislation Act 1989.
