# Ethnic Affairs Commission Regulation 1997

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe area health services established under the *Area Health Services Act 1986* and the Ambulance Service of New South Wales as public authorities for the purposes of the Act. Under the Act, as amended by the *Ethnic Affairs Commission Amendment Act 1996*, a public authority must observe the principles of cultural diversity in its affairs and may enter into ethnic affairs agreements with the Ethnic Affairs Commission.

This Regulation is made under the *Ethnic Affairs Commission Act 1979*, including section 5 and section 22 (the general regulation making power).

This Regulation comprises or relates to matters of a machinery nature.

## Ethnic Affairs Commission Regulation 1997

### 1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Ethnic Affairs Commission Regulation 1997*.

### 2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 7 February 1997.

### 3 Definitions

In this Regulation:

*the Act* means the *Ethnic Affairs Commission Act 1979*.

### 4 Notes

The explanatory note and table of contents in the text of this Regulation do not form part of this Regulation.

### 5 Public authorities

For the purposes of the definition of public authority in section 5 of the Act, the following are prescribed as public authorities:

- (a) an area health service within the meaning of the Area Health Services Act 1986,
- (b) the Ambulance Service of New South Wales.
