Farm Produce Amendment (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1997

under the
Farm Produce Act 1983

His Excellency, the Lieutenant-Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Farm Produce Act 1983*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal certain obsolete provisions of the *Farm Produce Regulation 1983* and to restrict the application of that Regulation to matters relating to farm produce sold by a producer before or on 30 June 1997, or sold by a farm produce agent on behalf of a producer before or on 30 June 1997, and for which payment became due no later than on 31 July 1997.

This Regulation is made under the *Farm Produce Act 1983*, including section 55 (the general regulation-making power).

This Regulation is made in connection with the staged repeal of subordinate legislation under the *Subordinate Legislation Act 1989*.

Farm Produce Amendment (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1997

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Farm Produce Amendment (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1997*.

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 31 August 1997.

3 Amendment

The *Farm Produce Regulation 1983* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

This Regulation applies to and in respect of farm produce sold by a producer before or on 30 June 1997, or sold by a farm produce agent on behalf of a producer before or on 30 June 1997, being farm produce for which payment became or becomes due no later than on 31 July 1997.
