## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to increase from \$84 to \$100 the annual roll fee for architects and the fee to restore an architect's name to the Register of Architects.

This Regulation is made under the *Architects Act 1921*, including section 25 (the general regulation-making power, in particular, section 25(1)(e)) and section 11.
