Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to classify the domestic yak (*Bos "grunniens"*) as a category 2 animal under the *Non-Indigenous Animals Act 1987*. This will allow a person holding a relevant licence or permit under that Act, or an authority to exhibit domestic yaks under the *Exhibited Animals Act 1986* (eg zoos), to import, move and keep animals of that species.

This Regulation is made under the *Non-Indigenous Animals Act 1987*, including sections 6 and 29 (the general regulation-making power).
