His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Poultry Meat Industry Act 1986*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is:

- (a) to require notice of upcoming appointments to the Poultry Meat Industry Committee to be given in the Gazette and posted to individual poultry processors (instead of by publication in a newspaper, as at present), and
- (b) to change the rate at which the application fee for approval of agreements between poultry processors and growers is calculated from \$100 for each 12 month agreement to \$122 for each 12 month agreement.

This Regulation is made under the *Poultry Meat Industry Act 1986*, including section 23.

1 Name of Regulation

Schedule 1 Amendments

(Clause 2)

[1] Clause 6 Notice of proposed appointment

Omit “at least one newspaper circulating generally throughout New South Wales” from clause 6 (1).

Insert instead “the Gazette, and at the same time sent by mail to each Association processor and independent processor”.

[2] Clause 6 (3)

Omit “first published”.

Insert instead “published in the Gazette”.

[3] Clause 7 Postponement of close of nominations

Omit “published” from clause 7 (1).

Insert instead “published and sent by mail”.

[4] Clause 43 Application fee

Omit “\$100”. Insert instead “\$122”.
