Explanatory note

This Regulation repeals the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1993* made under the Justices Act 1902. The provisions of that Regulation are being transferred, with minor amendments, to the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners Regulation 1995* made under the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners Act 1981*. The transfer is effected by means of the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners Amendment (Penalty Notice Offences) Regulation 1998* made under the same Act.

This Regulation is made under the general regulation-making power (section 34) of the *Justices Act 1902*.

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners (Short Description of Offences) Repeal Regulation 1998*.

3 Repeal

- (1) The *Periodic Detention of Prisoners (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1993* is repealed.
- (2) Any act, matter or thing that, immediately before the repeal of the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners (Short Description of Offences) Regulation 1993*, had effect under (or was done for the purposes of) that Regulation continues to have effect under (or is taken to have been done for the purposes of) the *Periodic Detention of Prisoners Regulation 1995*.
