Explanatory note

Under the *Lake Illawarra Authority Act 1987* the Lake Illawarra Authority may undertake certain development works for the purpose of improving the environment of Lake Illawarra, its foreshores and environs. These “development works” are specified in the Act, or additional works may be declared by regulations to be development works for the purposes of the Act.

The object of this Regulation is to declare that the construction of amenities blocks and educational study centres are development works for the purposes of the *Lake Illawarra Authority Act 1987*.

This Regulation is made under the *Lake Illawarra Authority Act 1987*, including section 5 (1) (definitions) and section 32 (the general regulation-making power).
