# Local Government (Savings and Transitional) Amendment (Records) Regulation 1999

## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal clause 5 of the *Local Government (Savings and Transitional) Regulation 1993*. Clause 5 deals with the preservation of council records. Provision for preservation of these and other records is now made by the *State Records Act 1998*.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including section 748 (the general regulation-making power) and clause 2 of Schedule 7 (which deals with savings, transitional and other provisions consequent on the enactment of that Act).
