# Jury Amendment (Fees) Regulation 1999

under the

Jury Act 1977

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Jury Act 1977*.

## Explanatory note

Section 72 of the *Jury Act 1977* provides that a person who attends court for jury service is entitled to be paid at the prescribed rate for that attendance. The object of this Regulation is to increase the attendance fees and refreshment allowance paid to jurors by approximately 2% and to provide that persons who attend for jury service for less than 4 hours but are not selected for jury service are only entitled to be paid a travelling allowance.

This Regulation is made under the *Jury Act 1977*, including sections 72 and 76 (the general regulation-making power).

## **Jury Amendment (Fees) Regulation 1999**

**1 Name of Regulation**

This Regulation is the *Jury Amendment (Fees) Regulation 1999*.

**2 Commencement**

This Regulation commences on 1 October 1999.

**3 Amendment of Jury Regulation 1999**

The *Jury Regulation 1999* is amended as set out in Schedule 1.

## Schedule 1 Amendments

(Clause 3)

**[1] Clause 7 Payment for jury service**

Omit “juror” from clause 7 (1).

Insert instead “person in attendance for jury service at a court or coronial inquest”.

**[2] Clause 7 (2)**

Omit “juror’s”. Insert instead “person’s”.

**[3] Clause 7 (2)**

Omit “juror” wherever occurring. Insert instead “person”.

**[4] Clause 7 (2)**

Omit “during the period of jury duty” wherever occurring.

Insert instead “at the time the person was in attendance for jury service,”.

**[5] Clause 7 (2)**

Omit “on jury duty” from clause 7 (2) (a).

Insert instead “attending for jury service”.

**[6] Schedule 2 Scales of daily fees and allowances payable in respect of persons attending for jury service**

Omit items (a) and (b) from the matter relating to the 1st day of attendance in Scale A.

Insert instead:

- (a) if a person attends for less than 4 hours on that day but is not selected for jury service ..... Nil

- (b) if a person attends for less than 4 hours on that day and is selected for jury service ..... 34.90
- (c) if a person attends for more than 4 hours on that day (whether or not the person is selected for jury service) .... 69.90

Omit “68.50” where secondly occurring. Insert instead “69.90”.

**[8] Schedule 2, Scale A**

Omit “79.70”. Insert instead “81.30”.

**[9] Schedule 2, Scale A**

Omit “93.00”. Insert instead “94.90”.

**[10] Schedule 2, Scale A**

Omit “If a juror is paid”.  
Insert instead “If a person attending for jury service is paid”.

**[11] Schedule 2, Scale A**

Omit “the juror’s full wage”. Insert instead “the person’s full wage”.

**[12] Schedule 2, Scale A**

Omit “See clause 9 (2)”. Insert instead “See clause 7 (2)”.

**[13] Schedule 2, Scale A**

Omit “a juror claims”. Insert instead “a person claims”.

**[14] Schedule 2, Scale B**

Omit “a juror’s place of residence as shown on the jury roll and the court or inquest attended, the juror”.

Insert instead “the place of residence of a person attending for jury service, as shown on the jury roll, and the court or inquest attended, the person”.

**[15] Schedule 2, Scale C**

Omit “\$5.10”. Insert instead “\$5.20”.
