## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe the fee payable for an application for authorisation to practise as a nurse practitioner. The fee prescribed is \$150.

This Regulation is made under the *Nurses Act 1991*, including section 19A (Nurse practitioners) and section 78 (the general regulation-making power).

**1 Name of Regulation**
