1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Motor Accidents Compensation (No 2) Amendment Regulation 2000*.

2 Amendment of Motor Accidents Compensation Regulation (No 2) 1999

The *Motor Accidents Compensation Regulation (No 2) 1999* is amended by omitting from paragraph (b) in Column 2 of Table B to clause 1 of Schedule 1 (**Maximum costs for legal services**) the matter “\$2,000” and by inserting instead the matter “\$20,000”.
