His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*.

Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to repeal the requirement that a registered club must display a notice providing information about the chances of winning a major prize from the use or operation of any approved gaming device. It is proposed that a different form of notice will replace the current requirement.

This Regulation is made under the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*, including section 44C (2) (e).
