Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to postpone the expiry of clause 25 of the *Fines Regulation 1997* (which deals with the enforcement of interstate fines) from 1 July 2000 to 1 January 2001.

This Regulation is made under the *Fines Act 1996*, including section 128 (the general power to make regulations) and clause 1 of Schedule 3 (the power to make regulations of a savings or transitional nature).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Fines Amendment (Enforcement of Interstate Fines) Regulation 2000.*

2 Commencement

This Regulation commences on 30 June 2000.

3 Amendment of Fines Regulation 1997

The *Fines Regulation 1997* is amended by omitting from clause 25 (9) the words "1 July 2000" and by inserting instead the words "1 January 2001".
