Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Medical Practice Regulation 1998* to remove a requirement that a benchtop or portable steriliser may only be used if it is specified in the *Australian Register of Therapeutic Goods* maintained under the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* of the Commonwealth.

This Regulation is made under the *Medical Practice Act 1992*, including section 194 (the general power to make regulations) and Schedule 4.
