Explanatory note

The objects of this Regulation are:

- (a) to prescribe certain offences under the *Road Transport (Driver Licensing) Regulation 1999* and the *Road Transport (Safety and Traffic Management) (Road Rules) Regulation 1999* as penalty notice offences, and
- (b) to prescribe short descriptions for those offences and the penalties payable for those offences if dealt with by way of penalty notice.

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*, including sections 15 and 71, and takes effect on 1 July 2000.
