The object of this Regulation is to provide that claims for payment under the *Petroleum Products Subsidy Act 1965* are to be in a form made available at, and lodged at or posted to, an office of AusIndustry, instead of an office of the Australian Customs Service.

This Regulation is made under the *Petroleum Products Subsidy Act 1965*, including sections 7 and 19 (the general regulation-making power).
