Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to reduce the fees payable under the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999* for access to information contained in the database of declarations and orders maintained under section 13 (3) of that Act and for information from records of the Roads and Traffic Authority (including certificates issued under section 46 of that Act).

This Regulation is made under the *Road Transport (General) Act 1999*, including section 71 (the general regulation-making power).
