Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to exempt certain decisions of the Director-General of the Department of Fair Trading made under section 64A of the *Fair Trading Act 1987* from the application of the internal review provisions of the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Act 1997*.

This Regulation is made under the *Administrative Decisions Tribunal Act 1997*, including sections 53 (11) (b) and 145 (the general regulation-making power).
