Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Local Government (Rates and Charges) Regulation 1999* to increase the maximum amount that may be fixed as a minimum ordinary rate from \$302 to \$310.

This Regulation is made under the *Local Government Act 1993*, including sections 548 (3) (a) and 748 (the general regulation-making power).
