Explanatory note

Clause 7 of the *Electricity Safety (Electrical Installations) Regulation 1998* prohibits the carrying out of electrical installation work otherwise than in accordance with the Australian and New Zealand Standard *AS/NZS 3000:2000 Electrical Installations* (known as the *Australian/New Zealand Wiring Rules*).

The object of this Regulation is to allow the Director-General of the Department of Fair Trading to exempt specified persons or specified classes of persons or all persons from the operation of specified provisions of the *Australian/New Zealand Wiring Rules*. Such an exemption may be given unconditionally or subject to conditions.

This Regulation is made under the *Electricity Safety Act 1945*, including section 37 (the general regulation-making power).

17 Exemptions from Australian/New Zealand Wiring Rules

- (1) The Director-General may:
 - (a) by order published in the Gazette, exempt a class of persons or all persons from the operation of clause 7 in relation to a specified provision or provisions of the *Australian/New Zealand Wiring Rules*, or
 - (b) by order in writing given to a specified person, exempt the person from the operation of clause 7 in relation to a specified provision or provisions of those Rules.
- (2) Such an exemption may be given unconditionally or subject to conditions.
