Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the maximum amount for which hoteliers who are authorised to keep approved gaming devices are permitted to cash cheques from \$200 to \$400.

This Regulation is made under the *Liquor Act 1982*, including section 156 (the general regulation-making power).
