Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the maximum amount for which clubs that are authorised to keep approved gaming devices are permitted to cash cheques from \$200 to \$400.

This Regulation is made under the *Registered Clubs Act 1976*, including section 73 (the general regulation-making power).
