## Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Freedom of Information Regulation 2000* (which classifies government agencies for the purpose of co-ordinating the release of information under the *Freedom of Information Act 1989*) as a consequence of the change of name of a government body and other administrative changes.

This Regulation is made under sections 7 (public authorities) and 69 (the general regulation-making power) of the Act.
