Explanatory note

Section 45 of the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983* enables the Auditor-General, if requested to do so, to inspect and audit the accounts and records of financial transactions of or relating to statutory bodies prescribed under section 44 of that Act.

The object of this Regulation is to prescribe Games Information Services Pty Ltd as a statutory body under section 44 of the Act.

This Regulation is made under the *Public Finance and Audit Act 1983*, including sections 64 (the general power to make regulations) and 44 (1).
