



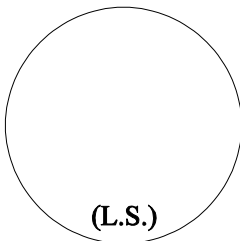

Water Management Act 2000 No 92—Proclamation

I, the Honourable Gordon Samuels AC, CVO, Governor of the State of New South Wales, with the advice of the Executive Council, and in pursuance of section 281 of the *Water Management Act 2000*, do, by this my Proclamation, amend Schedule 2 to that Act, to take effect as from 1 January 2001, by inserting in alphabetical order in that Schedule the corporate name “Macquarie Generation”.
