Explanatory note

The object of this Regulation is to increase the maximum mesh size for the cod-end of an otter trawl net used for taking prawns from 45 millimetres to 50 millimetres.

This Regulation is made under the *Fisheries Management Act 1994*, including sections 24 and 289 (the general power to make regulations).

1 Name of Regulation

This Regulation is the *Fisheries Management (General) Amendment (Otter Trawl Nets) Regulation 2000*.

2 Amendment of Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 1995

The *Fisheries Management (General) Regulation 1995* is amended by omitting “45 mm” wherever occurring in the Table to clause 34 (Otter trawl net (prawns)) and by inserting instead “50 mm”.
