Parliamentary Remuneration Amendment (Additional Salary and Allowance) Regulation 2000

His Excellency the Governor, with the advice of the Executive Council, has made the following Regulation under the *Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989*.

Explanatory note

Section 6 of the *Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989* provides for holders of certain offices (“recognised office holders”) specified in Schedule 1 to the Act to receive a salary and expense allowance in addition to the basic salary to which they are entitled as Members of Parliament. The additional salary and expense allowance to be received is expressed as a percentage of the basic salary.

The object of this Regulation is to amend the *Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989* so as:

- (a) to remove the reference in Schedule 1 to that Act to the Chairman of the Joint Standing Committee on Small Business, and
- (b) to provide for an additional salary and expense allowance for the Chairman of the Joint Standing Committee on Children and Young People.

This Regulation is made under the *Parliamentary Remuneration Act 1989*, including section 6 (Salary and expense allowance of recognised office holders).
