## **Explanatory note**

The object of this Regulation is to allow authorised officers and employees of the Royal Botanic Gardens and Domain Trust or the Parramatta Stadium Trust to issue penalty notices for certain offences under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act 1997*.

This Regulation is made under the *Protection of the Environment Operations Act* 1997, including sections 226 and 323 (the general regulation-making power).
