Insert after rule 5 (1) (ci):

(cii) if it is an ordinary statement of claim filed on or after 1 January 2002, for 1 month from the date on which it is filed or such further period as the Court may direct.

[4] Part 5, rule 5 (1) (d)

Omit the paragraph.
